

Youth Tutoring Program

2015 IMPACT REPORT

455 students

These students attended 15,225 tutoring sessions, 781 drop-in sessions and 4,137 summer sessions (total 20,143 sessions).

533 tutors

Both new (205) and returning (328) volunteer tutors supported YTP youth. Sixty-seven active tutors have served YTP for five or more years, and 20 have served YTP for 10 or more years!

Resulting in 13,266 hours of support

And 29,665 hours of student participation in mentoring, skill building, reading, homework help and summer learning.

"Tutors help my son understand things that I don't understand or can't do. YTP helps me every week."

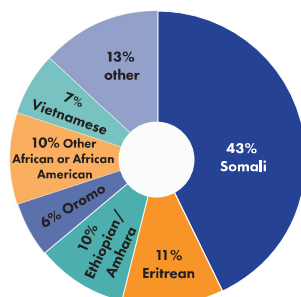
"My daughter can read and write more than before this program. That helps me know she will be okay even with a mother like me who cannot speak English."

Who we serve

YTP serves over 450 first through twelfth grade students each year. The vast majority of these students come from low income families.

78% come from families at or below 30% of the area median income

87% come from families where English is not the home language
